Camper pre-registration by the date in the gray box to right is required for the lowest camp fees or scholarship. Any camper registration form received after the pre-registration date will be charged a late fee of \$15. Campers can be pre-registered online at cmmbc.org , by mail, or by phone at 276-346-1013. Camp fees are due at camper registration on the first day of camp.		
PRE-approved scholarships are available. Please contact Joe or Tammy at 276-346-1013 to receive more information. Camper must be pre-registered to be eligible for a scholarship.		
Arrival: Registration is from 3-5 p.m. on Sunday. Departure: Camp ends following Chapel Service at 7 p.m. on Friday night. Families are Welcomed!

What to Leave at Home

The following items are **NOT** to be brought to camp. These items will be confiscated by the camp staff and be returned to the parent/guardian after the closing Chapel Service:

- cell phones
- electronic devices (games, pagers, MP3 players, I-pods, electronic notebooks, etc.)
- expensive jewelry

The following items are **NOT** to be brought to camp. These items can result in the camper being dismissed from camp:

- tobacco products
- drugs, even medications that were not turned in to the nurse
- weapons
- alcohol
- fireworks

Offering

Canteen

The Canteen is open each afternoon. Each camper is allowed to select 2 items and the cost is included in the camper fees. Food is not allowed in camper cabins. Bringing food items from home is discouraged, and any food must be stored in the canteen and will be available at canteen time only.
