QUALIFICATIONS OF RETURNING PAID SUMMER CAMP STAFF MEMBER...

We are excited that you desire to return to CMMBC to work as summer staff! Please join us in prayer as we seek to hire individuals who sincerely follow Christ and desire to share their Christian walk with campers. The re-application process is similar to your initial application process.

We are looking to hire two counselors (at least 1 year beyond high school graduation) for June and July. We may also hire qualified individuals as junior counselors (high school graduate) or junior staff (high school students). Qualified individuals must have:

- a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- a desire to serve others
- flexibility in dealing with different situations and people of all ages
- a willingness to be stretched
- a willingness to live without the internet or a cell phone
- the ability to lead others to follow the rules at camp
- the courage to hold yourself and others accountable to honor God in all circumstances
- the health and stamina to work outdoors during the summer

We may also hire a nurse, speaker or lead cook, as needed to support a week of camp. Qualified applicants will need the appropriate certification and/or experience. The camp nurse may be a LPN, RN or EMT.

JOB DESCRIPTION...

Ultimately, being a summer camp staff member is about building personal relationships with others to share the love of Jesus. The primary duties of a summer camp staff member at CMMBC can vary significantly from day-to-day and role.

Counselor, jr. counselor or jr. staff member: must be willing to cooperate as necessary to facilitate our camping program. Some of the duties include the willingness to:

- help with camp readiness (i.e. plan/organize activities, ensure cabins and bathhouses are clean and stocked)
- partner with mission team members to facilitate summer camp and work projects
- greet campers and help with camper registration and getting them settled into their group or cabin
- oversee campers' daily activities (i.e. cleanup duties, Chapel services/daily devotions, crafts, games, offsite excursions, mealtimes, personal hygiene and canteen)
- help maintain grounds and buildings
- help with meal preparation, service, and cleanup

Camp nurse is responsible for distribution of medication and handling first aid.

Lead cook is responsible for complying with food safety requirements, planning/preparing/serving meals, as well as supervising kitchen and dining hall cleanliness.

Camp speaker is responsible for teaching morning and evening Chapel Services.

HOW TO APPLY...

Here are the steps necessary to be considered for returning to a staff position:

- pray for God's direction in this decision.
- submit a returning staff application form to CMMBC. (Applications are available at cmmbc.org/staff-and-volunteer-forms/ or by calling Joe or Tammy at 276-346-1013 to request an application to be mailed to you). Hiring may happen upon interview of the first qualified candidate.
- fill in the top section of the personal reference form and give one to your pastor or Christian leader. Please ask him/her to mail the completed form directly to camp. Your application will not be complete until we have your reference form in hand.
- CMMBC will confirm your interest in a position at CMMBC within 1 week of receiving the completed application.

Our Expectations of Camp Staff

Staff members are expected to be present throughout the duration of their hiring period. Exact dates will be determined by CMMBC administration in consultation with potential camp staff. It is essential that all applicants be willing to:

- Share your relationship with Christ, through example and speech with campers and staff
- Enter into your position's responsibilities with a positive and supportive attitude.
- Sacrifice personal desires in the interest of the campers and your peers.
- Comply with general expectations and staff policies as outlined by summer management (i.e. attending camp planning meeting the day before camp starts, cell phone policy, etc.)

CMMBC prohibits the use of tobacco products and/or the drinking of alcoholic beverages by its summer staff, on or off duty. The use of drugs shall be limited to such as prescribed by a physician. Sexual immorality, either in practice or verbal endorsement, may provide grounds for discipline or dismissal, depending on the issue/event. The camp reserves the right to dismiss a worker for incompetence, misconduct, or failure to comply with camp policies.

Camp Staff Agreement

Covenant Mountain Mission Bible Camp is committed to sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ with the campers and other guests who come to the camp. As a potential staff member, I understand this, and pursue to model a Christian lifestyle to the campers and others.

I understand and agree to the standards of dress and conduct required of camp staff. I certify that all of the information that I have provided to CMMBC in this application is true. I give permission for CMMBC to verify the information by contacting the references that I have identified in order to determine my eligibility for work. I have provided a personal reference form to my pastor and at least one other reference listed in my application. Additionally, CMMBC has my permission to complete a background check for applicants over 18 years of age or have parental signature for those under age 18.

This agreement and application is signed prayerfully, understanding that the overall goal is to glorify the Lord. If I am accepted for a position, I will abide by the policies above and principles of ethics, conduct, and dress asked of me, and will accept my responsibility as a member of the camp community.

I realize that any photos or recordings taken of me during the summer may be used in camp promotional materials.
