Hardware:

1. Wireless Microphone - Samson Airline 88 - \$399
2. Bluetooth adapter - Logitech - \$20
3. Bluetooth mixer - Alesis Multimix 10 Wireless - \$295
4. iPad Pro - Apple - Starting at \$999
5. iPad to Projector Dongle - Apple - \$50
6. Powered Speakers - Mackie THUMP 15 - \$349/each
7. USB Microphone - Samson G-Track Pro - \$128

Apps:

1. Tonal Energy - Use for tuning and metronome.
2. Amazing Slow Downer - Use to slow down solos while transcribing
3. forScore - Import sheet music and edit. Use as a library in a tablet.
4. Garage Band - Have fun exploring different sounds, mixes and beats.
5. Voice Memo - Use conveniently to make quick recordings to upload to Google Classroom
6. Notion - For quick and easy part creation. Simple to use and intuitive.
7. Google Classroom - Post music, YouTube videos, musical clips and links for students.
8. Paper 51 - Use in place of a white board. Saves all of your lessons.
9. Drum Genius - Can use as a more interesting metronome for kids.
10. iRealPro - Amazing catalogue of backing tracks for most jazz standards.
11. ScannerPro - Use to scan sheet music into apps like forScore.
