

STAM POLICY - COMMERCIAL ATTENDEES

The Speech and Theatre Association of Missouri recognizes the importance of building relationships between educational and commercial entities. Because of the significance of these relationships, the STAM Board welcomes commercial members and encourages commercial members to display and market their products and services in the gallery during the conference. The STAM Board also welcomes workshops presented by commercial members. The STAM Board requires that marketing products and services is limited to the gallery and workshops presented will be educational in nature (no sales or advertising during workshops) and follow the pedagogy and assessment standards for speech and theatre education in Missouri. STAM Membership and Registration fees will not be waived in exchange for workshops. Space in the gallery is limited and will be allocated based on requests and capacity. Gallery space is open to those with paid memberships to STAM.
