



Glass Fusing

Discover the hottest trend in glass art. Glass fusing involves laying out different shapes of colored glass on a base and gluing them into place. The glass is fired in a kiln to melt the layers together, forming a smooth, textured surface. The resulting piece can be shaped into a dish with a second firing called slumping.

Workshops are offered for those who wish to learn safe cutting and handling of glass as well as tips on layout. There's no charge for the workshop, only the price of the piece. Workshops include use of tools and materials for up to three layers on top of a base. We recommend age 12 and above for safety reasons.

For those who wish to skip the workshop and create simple designs with pre-cut glass, e.g. night lights, coasters, suncatchers and jewelry, we offer open sessions on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons during Spring and Fall. Kids age 6 and up can do these.
