Envelopes shall, on the exterior, be designated as to the Contract for which the proposal is entered, and the name and address of the Bidder.

Bid proposals for up to \$400,000.00 must be accompanied by a negotiable bid guarantee which shall not be less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid, but not more than \$20,000.00. Bids over \$400,000.00 shall be accompanied with a negotiable bid guarantee of five percent (5%) of the bid amount.

The bid guarantee may be a certified check, bank draft, payable to the Housing Authority or a Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and Sureties acceptable to the U.S. Government and authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey.
