🗹 New Life

Read Jeremiah 33:14-16, watch the *Bible Background Video* for this session, and watch the Charlotte's Web clip.

- What does this clip tell us about death?
- What does this clip tell us about life? How does this clip relate to this week's scripture?
- How was new life coming even though the situation seemed hopeless?
- What kind of hopeless situation were the people experiencing in this week's text? How were Jeremiah's words a message of hope? How did this text describe the new life that Israel would someday experience? Why would that give them hope?

🧭 Hopeless

- Have you ever found yourself in a hopeless situation? What was it like? How did you get out of it?
- Watch the video from The Life of Pi.

• Why does Pi seem to be in a hopeless situation? Where does he turn for help?

Praithele

- Give some examples of experiences you or your friends have gone through that could potentially seem hopeless.
- How does God help us through these difficult situations?
- Have you experienced a time when God showed up in an unexpected way? Explain.
- How is Christmas about God showing up in an unexpected way?
- How can we celebrate God's new life and new hope during this Christmas season?
