- What phrases or words in this passage convey a message of hope?
- Why might this passage help those living in exile to understand that the future looks more promising for their people?
- How do you know the author is confident about this prophecy?

- What is your opinion of the definitions of hope given in this clip? How would you define hope?
- Do you think hope is a Christian characteristic? Why or why not? What does a Christian without hope look like? Why? Why does a Christian need hope? Why does the world need hope?
- How can we as Christians help people to know the hope that is in Christ Jesus?
