# A. Approval of 9.27.17 Minutes

#### B. Potluck debrief

- 1. Began the discussion of what type of event this might be in the future- a community event, a PS 11 family event or a hybrid where PS 11 families and neighbors are invited.
- 2. New rule for next potluck: children can only go inside the building with a grownup. One member of the SLT will be stationed at the door at the top of the steps to monitor.
- 3. Things to have at next year's event: gloves for servers, band-aids.

#### C. Curriculum Night:

- 1. Attendance was up from last year with about 160 parents attending each night.
- 2. Reviewed survey results. 85% of respondents said the evening was "very helpful". Note for next year: the survey should be sent out the day after Curriculum Night.
- 3. Surveys indicated some parents would like more time during the event to ask questions.
- 4. Surveys also indicated parents would like to add a social component to the evening. At our April meeting SLT will look into finding a local establishment to host a post-event gathering.
