D. Curriculum Night:

- 1. Debbie to coordinate child care and food for kids. She said there was a lot of food left over last year due to low attendance at the 3rd, 4th, 5th grade Curriculum Night. Parents will be asked to RSVP for childcare and food at this year's event. Teachers will email parents about this.
- 2. K-2 Curriculum Night (Sept 27): Rachel, Carrie Beth to help pass out numbers.

E. Bylaws: the team went over the draft of the by laws.



- 1. Size of the SLT Team will be 13 comprised of 5 elected parents, 4 teachers, UFT rep, principal, PTA rep and elected CBO rep.
- 2. Will hold emergency elections to fill mid-term vacancies
- 3. Members can't miss more than 2 meetings or they will be asked to resign or be removed. Members must attend at least 3/4 of a meeting to be considered present.
- 4. Because these are public meetings and press can attend, team wants to add language to specify guidelines for filming during meetings.
- 5. Team wants to add language that specifies requests to speak at SLT meeting must be submitted in writing and approved by the chairperson.
- 6. Members will vote on by laws at the next meeting.

F. Character/K and G/Kindness: This year's theme is compassion

- 1. There are five books,three videos and one quote teachers will use to teach compassion. Teachers will do three classroom activities around the selection of the month.
 - The Boy Who Grew Flowers by Jennifer Wojtowicz
 - <u>Under the Lemon Moon</u> by Rene King Moreno
 - Great Joy by Kate DiCamillo
 - How to Heal a Broken Wing by Bob Graham
 - Red by Jan De Kinder
 - Video 1: Sesame Street song about kindness
 - Video 2: commercial depicting random acts of kindness
 - Video 3: rap video about passing on kindness
 - Quote: "No matter how bad you think things are, someone has it worse."
 - Students will choose what medium to use during the final month
- 2. Bob would like this study of compassion to include a conversation with the community. Jordan will contribute literature that can help facilitate this conversation and help teachers talk about compassion. Bob was interested in having a team of teachers study this. Jordan will set up the team and check in with them.
