HOME OF  
THE AMERICAN NEWS WOMEN'S CLUB

CONVENIENTLY LOCATED AT 1607 22ND STREET, NW IN THE HEART OF WASHINGTON'S EMBASSY ROW, CRANFORD HOUSE SERVES AS A FREQUENT GATHERING PLACE FOR THE CITY'S MEDIA LEADERS, RESIDENT DIGNITARIES, HUMANITARIAN ADVOCATES AND CORPORATE PACESETTERS. THE ELEGANT BRICK AND LIMESTONE FRENCH REVIVAL TOWNHOUSE WAS CUSTOM-DESIGNED IN 1906 FOR WASHINGTON BUSINESS SCION, JOSEPH CRANFORD, BY THE FIRM OF A.B. MULLETT AND CO., ARCHITECTS OF THE OLD EXECUTIVE OFFICE BUILDING AND SUPERVISING ARCHITECTS OF THE U.S. TREASURY BUILDING.

JOSEPH CRANFORD WAS A CO-OWNER OF THE CRANFORD COMPANY WHICH SPECIALIZED IN PAVING AND MASONRY. THE CRANFORD COMPANY WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN HELPING TO REALIZE PIERRE L'ENFANT'S DESIGN FOR THE CITY OF WASHINGTON WHEN, IN 1901, A U.S. SENATE COMMISSION SET ABOUT RESTORING L'ENFANT'S ORIGINAL URBAN PLAN IN ANTICIPATION OF THE CITY'S CENTENNIAL AS THE NATION'S CAPITOL. UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF LEADING ARCHITECTS AND LANDSCAPE DESIGNERS, THE CRANFORD COMPANY HELPED TO CREATE THE URBAN AND CULTURAL DESIGN OF WASHINGTON THAT IS ADMIRER AND ENJOYED TODAY.


SINCE 1961 CRANFORD'S FORMER RESIDENCE HAS BEEN HOME TO THE AMERICAN NEWS WOMEN'S CLUB. THE ANWC WAS FOUNDED IN 1932 AS A NEWSPAPER WOMEN'S CLUB AND INCLUDED THREE FIRST LADIES - MRS. CALVIN COOLIDGE, MRS. HERBERT HOOVER AND MRS. FRANKLIN ROOSEVELT AMONG ITS FOUNDING MEMBERS. SINCE THEN, EVERY FIRST LADY THROUGH MRS. GEORGE W. BUSH HAS JOINED THE ANWC AS AN HONORARY MEMBER, A DISTINCTION WHICH WAS ALSO EXTENDED TO SUCH

NOTABLE WOMEN AS AMELIA EARHART AND QUEEN ELIZABETH. THE ANWC EMBRACES A DIVERSE GROUP OF JOURNALISTS, PROFESSIONAL COMMUNICATORS REPRESENTING THE COMPLETE SPECTRUM OF THE GLOBAL MEDIA INDUSTRY, PUBLISHING COMPANIES, PUBLIC RELATIONS FIRMS, CORPORATIONS, ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS AND GOVERNMENT.
