

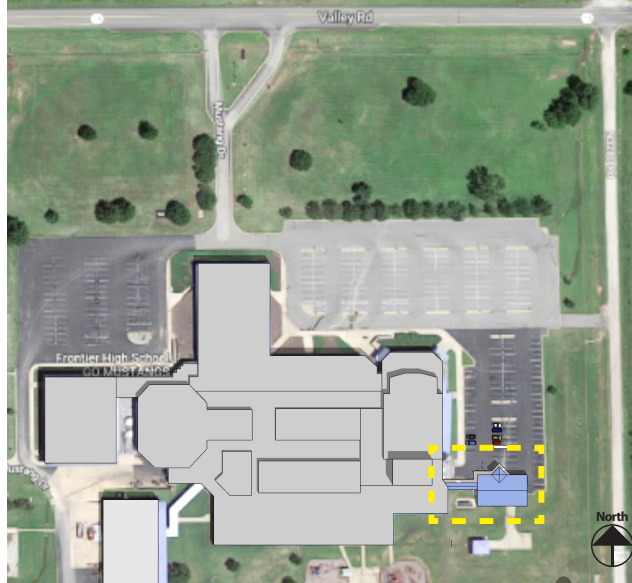

What's Included: Safe Room Building

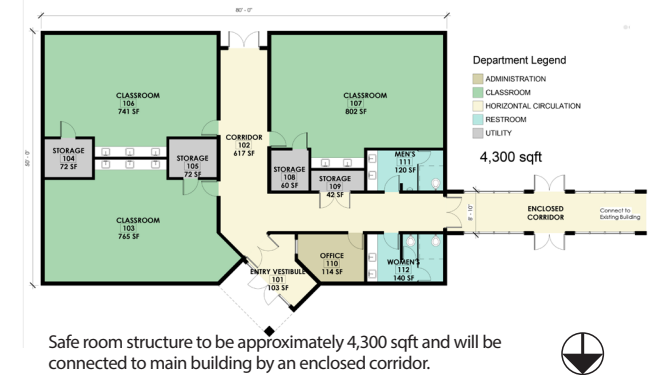
- Approximately 4,300 sqft
- Will hold over 500 people in a severe weather event
- Will be used as a multi-purpose facility in normal use (classrooms, meetings rooms, etc.)
- Close to existing children's wing
- Easily accessible for community
- Designed to meet or exceed all FEMA P-361 (community safe room) standards.

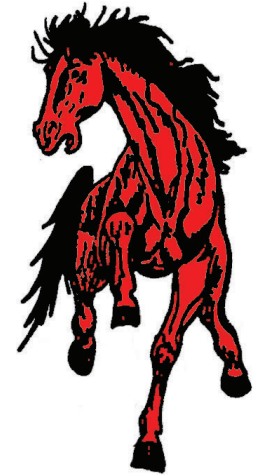
\$1.2 Million
