

Eligibility Criteria for WMEF College Scholarships

The **Wisconsin Mathematics Education Foundation** currently offers two \$2,000 scholarships to qualified students currently enrolled in teacher education programs in the state of Wisconsin. To be eligible students must

- be a legal resident of Wisconsin
- currently be enrolled in a Wisconsin public or private teacher education program
- currently be enrolled in or have already completed a course in methods of teaching mathematics, and
- currently have a GPA of at least 3.00 (B average) or better.

If the applicant is a *secondary* major, he/she must have successfully completed 16 credits in mathematics. A statistics and a computer programming or technology application course must be part of the undergraduate/graduate program.

If the applicant is an *elementary* major, his/her program must include 6 credits of mathematics. Some statistics concepts and some computer/technology knowledge must be part of the undergraduate/graduate program.
