The Hall Bed & Breakfast

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The Hall Bed and Breakfast in Holywell, North Wales, is a lovely historic B&B. The accommodation is in a Jacobean cottage full of character and set in quiet and intriguing grounds. Fully self-contained, the accommodation includes a fully-equipped kitchen, dining room and sitting room.

There are two bedrooms with private bathroom facilities (shared bathroom exclusively for the use of guests). We only ever let The Hall to one party. If you book one room, we will not let the other room to anyone else. This means you will have The Hall to yourself during your stay.

Breakfast is freshly cooked on the Aga stove using local produce.

Prices are from £40 per person for single occupancy to £30 per person for 4 people sharing (prices include breakfast).

The Hall has a walled garden, an icehouse and is surrounded by acres of fields. Jacobean and Grade II listed, it has huge stone walls which make it a very comfortable place to stay throughout the year.

We are ideally situated for users of the Holyhead to Dublin / Dun Laoghaire ferry route, being just over an hour from Holyhead.

The Hall is just minutes from the A55, perfectly situated for exploring North Wales and Snowdonia, Chester and Liverpool and North West England.

◆ **Accessibility**

The accommodation at The Hall is on several levels, with stairs to the bedrooms which are both on the first floor. Parking is directly outside the accommodation, with a sloping cobbled surface and steps down into the accommodation. The cobbles are the original farmyard surface, and are consequently rather uneven. There is a flight of 4 steps down from the yard into the accommodation, with a handrail on the left and a right-angle turn into the back door, with a couple of steps down to floor level.

◆ **Ground floor**

The Entrance Hall is tiled, with a 4" step leading to the Courtyard Hall and other rooms. The Courtyard Hall leads into the Sitting Room; the Kitchen; and the Dining Room. The Sitting Room and Kitchen floors are tiled with rugs and carpets; while the Dining Room floor is tiled. Doorways are variable in width, but are around 3'6" - 4' wide.

The Kitchen is fully equipped.

◆ **First Floor**

Both the bedrooms and the bathroom are on the First Floor, which is reached via a single flight of stairs (13 steps with a handrail on the left). There is a small carpeted landing which leads into the Twin Room and the Double Room. There are low wooden beams on the landing and in the Double Room. Both bedrooms are carpeted throughout.

The Twin Room and Double Rooms both have a washbasin.

The private Bathroom is reached from the landing, via two steps leading down into the bathroom. The Bathroom has hard wood floor. There is a WC, washbasin and bath with electric shower. This bathroom is exclusively for guests' use.

We of course offer guests every assistance, but due to the age of the building, wheelchair users may find it difficult to move around and negotiate the doorways and changes in level. Please call us on 01352 780215 if you would like more information.
