When God set apart the tribe of Levi to serve Him as priests, they helped the Israelites learn about sacrifices. God required blood as part of the sacrifice to remind them of the seriousness of their sins. A pure animal had to be chosen to be a worthy sacrifice. Giving up the life of a sickly or injured animal would not mean anything to the Israelites. In the same way, when Jesus gave up His life, His blood was a worthy sacrifice for our sins.
