 - Make your selections
 - When you review your order prior to checking out, choose **“Part of a Group.”**
 - Go to **“Check Out Securely”** and enter:

The Bulbs

Bulb size: Selections are topsize bulbs (the largest size available in the commercial market) unless otherwise noted.

Hardiness: All plants hardy to Z4 unless noted.

Bloom time: VE – Very early spring

MS – Mid spring

ESu – Early summer

E – Early spring

LS – Late spring

Su – Summer

Early Shipment of Fall Crocus and Peonies: Bulbs will arrive early Sept and should be picked then

Fall Crocus

E6101B **Colchicum, The Giant** (Fall) 6-8". Z4-9. Violet to rosy pink 3" flowers open nearly flat and will spread over time. Maine Grown/Organic. **3/\$14.50**

E6104B **Saffron Crocus** (Fall) 3-4". Z5-9; Valued for orange-red pollen. Lilac/purple veined flowers. Full sun, well-drained, heavy winter mulch. May not flower first autumn. **10/\$5.15**

E6106B **Crocus speciosus** (Fall) 4". Z4-9. Violet blue flowers with fringed stamens on long stems. Plant closely for support or among ground covers. Spreads easily. **10/\$3.80**

Peonies – all double, most fragrant! (LS-ESu) Z3-8

- E6126A **Ben Franklin** Hardy late bloomer. 20-24"; Deep red w/slight lavender tinge. Prolific bloomer, tantalizing fragrance. **1/\$8**
E6127A **Bowl of Beauty** 24-30"; sublime bicolor w/pastel rose-red petals inside, soft pink outside. **1/\$8.50**
E6128A **Duchess de Nemours** Early. 28-32"; fragrant, white, 5-7" flowers; ruffled inner petals, yellow base. Sturdy. **1/\$8.50**
E6129A **Koppius** Mid-season, 20-24"; deep rich carmine bowl-shaped, very large flowers with heady fragrance. **1/\$8.25**
E6130A **Sarah Bernhardt** Late. 32-36"; 6-8" fragrant, rose pink flowers mature to delicate pink w/ silvery edge. **1/\$6.50**

Seed Garlic

- 6224A **Inchellium Red** (Eco-grown, ME) Softneck. 2-3 inner cloves, 6-7 outer. Decent keeper; bolt resistant. **3 bulbs/\$13**
6226A **Georgian Fire** (OG, ME) Z3-8. Hardneck. 4-6 lg cloves/bulb. Fiery. Excellent keeper. Good for salsa/pesto. **3 bulbs/\$15**
6237A **Russian Red** (OG, ME) Z3-8. Hardneck. 5-8 plump cloves/bulb. Mottled burgundy skin. Keeps for 6 mos. **3 bulbs/\$14**

Crocus

- 6351B **Species Crocus Mix** (VE) 2-4"; Mix of species in white, yellow, purple. **40/\$5.75**
6358B **Yellow Mammoth** (VE-ES) 4-6"; Most popular crocus for 300 years! Vigorous; spreads by offsets. **20/\$5.85**
6364B **Jumbo Crocus Mix** (VE-ES) 4-6"; Yellow, purple, blue, white & stripes **40/\$8.25**

Iris

- 6509A **Butter and Sugar Siberian Iris** (Su) 26-28"; White standards, butter-yellow falls. **1/\$4**
6510A **Susan's Siberian** (Su) Eco-grown, ME; 36-42"; Deep rich blue, like Caesar's Brother. **1/\$3.75**

Narcissus (Daffodils) (landscape size bulbs unless noted) Z3-8

- 6602B **Sunshine Mix** (ES-MS) 14-18"; Large Cup narcissus of all colors; cups rimmed in red, orange, pink. Outstanding! **20/\$8.75**
6605B **Fragrant Mix** (MS-LS) 14-18"; Sweetly scented varieties. Great in the garden and for indoor bouquets. **20/\$9.85**
6618B **Dutch Master** (ES-MS) 18-20"; Yellow petals, straight trumpet, flared, notched rim. Better than King Alfred! **20/\$8.00**
6620B **Carlton topsize** (ES-MS) 18-20"; Yellow petals, deeper golden cup. Multiplies rapidly; vanilla scent. **10/\$5.75**
6624B **Ice Follies** (ES-MS) 16-18"; White petals; wide ribbed cup that opens yellow/turns creamy white. **20/\$7.40**
6625A **Pink Pride topsize** (MS) 22-28"; White petals, white throated cup w/soft peach-pink rim. **10/\$6.00**
6635B **Actaea topsize** (MS-LS) 16-18"; Rounded white petals; small, shallow, red-rimmed, yellow cup. Tolerates some damp. Source of narcissus oil used in perfumery. **10/\$8.75**

Tulips *Darwin hybrids are often called "perennial tulips" because they last for many years w/o replanting.

- 6901B **Apricot Beauty** (ES) 42-16"; Apricot/pink tinged with rose w/green base. Fragrant, for forcing. **10/\$6.40**
6903B **Red Emperor** (ES) 12-16"; Huge blooms of fiery red with yellow/black base. Great w/daffodils! **10/\$5.50**
6907B **Passionale** (MS) 14-16"; Lilac purple w/deeper purple flames. **10/\$5.60**
6909B **Princess Irene** (MS) 12-14"; Fragrant salmon-apricot-orange petals w/plum-violet flame. **10/\$5.00**
6910B **Shirley** (MS) 18-20"; Ivory w/widening purple edge; changes day to day. **10/\$5.90**
6912B ***Daydream** (MS) 20-28"; Darwin hybrid. Fragrant. Opens yellow, matures to apricot w/yellow & rose blushes. **10/\$4.80**
6913B ***Golden Oxford** (MS) 20-24"; Darwin hybrid. Bold golden yellow blooms. Pair w/ Oxford for great combo. **10/\$4.60**
6914B ***Ollioules** (MS) 20-28"; Darwin hybrid. Pinky cream brushed w/silvery pink & lavender. Elegant! **10/\$5.25**
6917B ***Oxford** (MS) 20-28"; Darwin hybrid. Bright scarlet w/purple red blush, yellow base & black stamens - brilliant! **10/\$4.60**
6920B **Kingsblood** (LS) 24-28"; Dk cherry red w/scarlet edges; one of best reds. **10/\$5.50**
6921B **Maureen** (LS) 24-28"; Marble white w/pastel yellow undertones. **10/\$7.60**
6922B **Menton** (LS) 24-28"; Pink w/violet hints & apricot edge; salmon on inside. **10/\$5.25**
6923B **Mrs John Scheepers** (LS) 24-28"; Possibly best yellow ever! **10/\$7.40**
6958B ***Darwin Mix** (MS) 20-28"; Darwin hybrid. Red, yellow, white, pink, apricot & more. **20/\$8.85**

Miscellaneous Bulbs

- 6309A **Drumstick allium** (Su) Purple/maroon oval heads (1-2") on tall stems; very long lasting; great in borders or cut. **10/\$2.50**
6704A **Indian hyacinth (Camassia)** (ESu) 12-16"; Spikes of silvery-blue, starry blooms; strong stems; moist spot/woods edge. **10/\$3**
6719B **English bluebells** (MS) 12-18"; Arching racemes of fragrant, flax-blue flowers; good under deciduous trees. **20/\$9.40**
