ITINERARY

✤December 2, DAY 1, Sunday: DEPART U.S.A

Depart for Mexico City. Upon arrival you are greeted by our tour escort and transferred to the hotel. Dinner at the hotel, in the historical area of the city, an active area filled with shops, markets and restaurants. Welcome Mass at Our Lady of Good Remedies where we also see the giant statue of St. Michael the Archangel. In the evening we see the Mariachi bands playing in Garibaldi Square. Overnight Mexico City. (Dinner at a local restaurant)

廿Dec. 3, DAY 2, Monday: MEXICO CITY – OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE – PYRAMIDS OF THE SUN AND THE MOON

Morning buffet breakfast. After breakfast, transfer to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe (Patroness of the Americas), by way of the Plaza of the Three Cultures. We will visit the Church of Santiago Tlatelolco where St. Juan Diego was baptized. This plaza is important as it symbolizes the unique blend of pre-Hispanic, and Hispanic cultures that make up Mexico. Continue to the Shrine of Guadalupe built in response to Our Lady's request to the visionary, St. Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin. Upon arrival at the Shrine, we will celebrate Mass as we marvel at the brilliantly colored Basilica. Following Mass, we will join the other pilgrims as we kneel in front of the "Tilma", where Our Lady's image was miraculously imprinted. Following this visit, we will make our way to San Juan Teotihuacan, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. According to mythology, this site was chosen to be the center of the universe, and from then it became a prominent political and religious center from the second century until the ninth century. While in San Juan Teotihuacan, we enjoy lunch at a nearby restaurant, followed by a guided tour of the Archaeological zone. We will view the Pyramids of the Sun and Moon and learn more about how the Aztecs worked the obsidian stone and the multiple uses of the Maguey Plant. Our fun, activity-filled day will culminate with a delicious dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, Lunch is included, Dinner at the hotel)

✤December 4, DAY 3, Tuesday: FULL DAY EXCURSION TO PUEBLA

Morning buffet breakfast, and then depart for Puebla - City of the Angels and Churches, the fourth largest city in México and a great example of Spanish colonial architecture. The Puebla region is famous for its beautiful Churches and its hand painted "Talavera" tiles. We visit the unforgettable Chapel of the Rosary where we celebrate Mass and have the opportunity for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. We then visit the Cathedral, Santo Domingo Church and the Santa Monica Religious Museum, and Church of St. Francis to see the incorrupt body of St. Sebastian. In the afternoon, we have ample time to shop in the open-air market and bargain for mementos or possibly silver. Overnight Mexico City. (B, Lunch is included, Dinner at the hotel)

✤Dec. 5, DAY 4, Wednesday: MEXICO CITY

Buffet breakfast. This morning we celebrate Mass at the Holy Family Church, where we view the tomb of Fr. Miguel Agustin Pro, the Jesuit martyr. In a time of great religious persecutions, Fr. Pro was exiled from Mexico during the Mexican Revolution. However, he returned to Mexico and was aided by a secret ministry who helped hide him from authorities. During his time in Mexico, he assisted many individuals in their spiritual, as well as temporal, needs. Although he helped many, he was eventually arrested and killed by authorities. After this visit, we will tour the oldest and largest cathedral in all Latin America, the Metropolitan Cathedral. Throughout our time in the Cathedral, we will be overwhelmed by the stunning paintings, altar pieces, and statues. Our tour continues with a transfer to the National Palace. This extraordinary palace has been a fixture of the ruling class of Mexico since the Aztec Empire's rule. During this visit, we will be able to view some amazing murals painted by Diego Rivera. Return to our hotel to enjoy a delicious dinner and rest before the next day of activities. Overnight Mexico City. (B, Dinner at the Hotel)

✤Dec 6, DAY 5, Thursday: MEXICO CITY – OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

Morning breakfast buffet. After breakfast, transfer to the Church of the 5th apparition, where the Blessed Virgin Maria de Guadalupe appeared to Juan Bernardino, Juan Diego's uncle. Here we can find a well of healing water which locals drink. We return to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe to celebrate Mass, and bid farewell to this Shrine of Mary, the Mother of God. Tonight, we have a tour of the Floating Gardens followed by time at leisure before our fun and festive Farewell Dinner in a local restaurant with Mariachi Music. Overnight Mexico City. (B, Special Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant)

✤Dec. 7, DAY 6, Friday: DEPART MEXICO CITY FOR USA

Time permitting, we celebrate Mass followed by transfer to the airport and our return flight home. (B)
