

Stunt Camp FAQ

How much does it cost? It is \$495 a week.

How much do I have to put down to register? \$95 payment is required to register,

What is Stunt Camp? In a 40 hour week kids learn how people get shot in movies, how buildings are burned, and even how stunt people are safely lit on fire using special insulating suits (No, we don't set kids on fire). They learn the basics of flame chemistry, of electric circuits, and of Newton's laws. By the end of the week, they have ridden on ziplines, learned to rappel, and understand the fundamentals of stunt safety. This camp keeps up with kids' voracious appetites for knowledge and adventure.

When are drop off and pick up times? Drop off is between 8:30am and 9:00am, pick up is between 4:00pm and 4:30pm.

Can I pick up my child later than 5pm? You may pick up your child no later than 5:45 for an additional \$25.

Do the children have to be athletic? Stunt Camp is designed for all children to enjoy. Our staff makes sure that each child is able to safely enjoy every activity, and that no one is left out.

Do you provide lunch for the children? Campers bring their own lunches and two snacks.

Will my children be learning dangerous behavior? No, kids will not learn dangerous things at camp. They will learn the science behind the stunts.

Do you offer anything longer than a week? Many children return for two and three weeks of Stunt Camp. This gives the camper a chance to practice the skills learned in previous weeks.

What if I have to cancel? If we are able to find a replacement camper for your camper, you will receive an 80% refund. There is no penalty if you need to change weeks due to illness.
