FOR CHILDREN / TEEN CHORISTERS

- Rehearsals begin Tuesday, September 11th and will be held in the St. Peter School Rooms 102 and 103.
- The choirs will sing at Masses according to the 2018 - 2019 choral schedule. Members are expected to arrive **30 minutes** prior to each Mass (unless otherwise noted) to warm up in the Music Room.
- Proper classroom etiquette is required. Insubordination will result in parental notification and may include dismissal from the choir.
- Choir members are responsible for their music. If original scores are lost, parents will be required to repurchase the material.
- Students may bring water in closed containers to the rehearsals and liturgical performances. All other food and drink is not permitted.

- Dress for rehearsals should be normal, comfortable, daily attire. Dress for Mass and other liturgical celebrations should be Sunday's best.
- Mature Christian behavior is expected at all times. Respect for individuals, the community, and the facilities is required. Teasing, harassment (this includes bullying), inappropriate comments or jokes, etc. are unacceptable in this Christian environment.
