





RODEO EVENTS (ANNOUNCER BROUGHT TO YOU BY YEGUA CREEK CATTLE CO. LLC)

STEER TYING (A/C TECHNICAL SERVICES, LTD.)

Taken from the life on the range of the working cowboy, steer tying has developed from the chore of securely tying a full-grown steer that is in need of medical attention.

- All team members can participate.
- Catch steer, do not "trip" or abuse.
- Legal head catch only. See ground rules. If team wants to heel the steer, they must have a legal head catch first.
- Tie any three (3) legs together.
- Must remove all other ropes steer must stay tied until all cowboys are mounted back on horseback.
- Time will stop when the last cowboy to mount has his leg over the horses back.

CALF BRANDING

The cowboys always look forward to roundup when the newborn calves are vaccinated and branded for identification purposes.

- All team members may participate
- Catch calf, do not "trip," abuse or drag the calf.
- Legal head catch only. See ground rules. If team wants to heel the calf, they must have a legal head catch first.
- Brander can leave the bucket area when the calf is caught.
- Calf must be on the ground and restrained by at least one member. Calf must then be branded on the "Right Rib".
- Brander will return brand to bucket.
- Time will stop when brand is returned and placed in the bucket (which is standing) and brander puts both hands in the air. Evidence of the brand making its mark must be on the calf or the team may be disqualified.





HUMAN DOT RACES

A whole new twist on an age old game.

WILD COW MILKING

When a "momma cow" is unable to provide milk for her calf, the cowboy must step in and retrieve the milk for the hungry calf.

- All team members can participate.
- Catch cow, do not "Trip" or abuse.
- Legal head catch only. See ground rules. NO HEELING in this event.
- Milk cow while she is standing, not kneeling. If the cow is down, the "Milker" may not continue to milk until she is back up.
- "Milker" must bring milk back across the finish line.
- Do not drink or pour milk out until okayed by the judge. Must prove to judge that milk is in the bottle.

STEER LOADING (M&M METALS INC.)

This team of working cowboys must work in unison to catch and load a wild steer from the pasture.

- All team members can participate
- Catch steer, do not "trip" or abuse.
- Legal head catch only. See ground rules. If team wants to heel the steer, they must have a legal head catch first.
- Trailer will be stationary in arena.
- Must load steer into trailer, close gate and latch it properly for time to stop.

CALF SCRAMBLE (ALAMO DUMPSTERS)

Children 12 and under may participate.

RESCUE RACE (TWISTED X BOOTS AND BILLY'S WESTERN WEAR)

The rain is falling and our fellow cowboys are stranded on the other side of the river. Our ranch hands must bring them home to safety.

- Two teams will compete at a time and all team members may participate.
- Rider must "rescue" three stranded cowboys at the opposite end of arena, one at a time.
- Rider must advance down the arena to rescue the cowboys and cross the river (tarp), returning to the finish line each time.
- Rider must rescue the cowboys from on top of the barrel.
- Rider must change horses at least once.
- If the rescued cowboy's feet hit the ground at anytime during the run he must return to the top of the barrel to be rescued again.
- Time will stop when the last cowboy is rescued and brought across the finish line.

HIDE RACE (DESERVICES AND LAW OFFICES OF KRISTI DENT) When the work is done, there is always enough energy for a little horseplay.

- Drag hide with (1) rider on board from start line to back line.
- Change cowhide riders and return to finish line for time to stop.
 Hide must cross the back line when the 1st rider dismounts and the 2nd rider mounts.
- Rider's hands must be in the paint when time starts and when crossing the back line.
- If either rider falls off, the hide must be brought back to the rider, the rider cannot advance forward to the hide.













SATURDAY - JULY 30TH

SOME GROUND RULES:

ABUSE OF LIVESTOCK - Any unnecessary abuse of the livestock, determined at the sole discretion of the Flagman and Arena Director, will result in a "No Time" and No Points in that event. At no time will an animal be drug or pulled by 1 hind leg. If an animal is down on the ground it may not be drug or pulled more than 3 feet in any direction.

MAXIMUM MEMBERS PER TEAM - Maximum members on a team are 5. If a team starts out with less than 5 they can pick up other members as the rodeo proceeds. Teams may not substitute a contestant except in the event of injury.

PARTICIPATION ON MULTIPLE TEAMS - A contestant can participate on multiple teams. The rodeo producer will not give any concession to back-to-back runs.

DRESS CODE - All contestants must wear western attire, including hat, long sleeve shirt, jeans, boots and chaps.

ANIMAL PERFORMANCE - If an animal, for whatever reason, fails to perform to the judge's satisfaction, a decision will be made to give the team a rerun.

TRIP - "FAIR GROUNDING" - a trip may not be intentionally placed on any animal at any time. This includes having a legal head catch and then intentionally letting the animal get around or over the rope before pulling the animal down.

LEGAL CATCHES - 3 LEGAL HEAD CATCHES - Slick Horns, Half Head or Neck. Heeling will be allowed only after there is a legal head catch. "No heeling in the Cow Milking"!

10 SECOND PENALTY - a 10 second penalty will be accessed for crossing the start line before the flag is dropped.

TIME LIMIT - Any event not completed in the time limit of 3 minutes (180 seconds) will result in a "No Time" and result in 0 points.

SPORTSMANSHIP - Contestants should observe discipline, good sportsmanship, and proper behavior. No loud or persistent profanity, no inhumane treatment of animals (gouging, kicking, whipping), etc. Any participant found to be conducting himself in an unsportsmanlike or inappropriate manner will be disqualified.

DISPUTES - The Flagman and the Arena Director will make judgment decisions as they arise. Anyone disagreeing with the decision can file a grievance with the Committee.

POINTS - Points will be awarded in each event, based on the number of teams entered in the rodeo. The top 8 teams based on points will advance to the Finals. Teams will start in the Finals with no points. The winners of the Finals will be based on points awarded in each event 8 - 1. If there is a tie on points, then the tie will be resolved with the fastest overall time on the 4 speed events, therefore breaking the tie.

SARRF - POINTS AWARDED (1ST =10 POINTS, 2ND=7, 5, 3, 2 & 1)



In 2012, the 16th Annual Bar-B-Que Cook-off and Concert will be held, as the third largest in the United States with more than 25,000 people in attendance. The Bar-B-Que Committee (Corral Club) is proud to host the first event of the Stock Show season and be a contributor to the S.A.L.E. scholarship fund.

While the Cook-off is managed under the name of the Bar-B-Que Committee, our organization still believes in its grass roots. The Ring of Fire Ranch Rodeo and Concert has become the Corral Club's way of continuing to directly support the Junior Livestock Auction. With ten ranch rodeos under our belt, the Corral Club has been able to make record contributions to the auction exceeding \$350,000 cumulatively. In 2011 alone, over 160 kids were assisted by our organization. These figures make our organization extremely proud, considering our humble beginnings. However, what makes us continue to grow the event are the thank you letters we received each year from the children of the auction. They are truly amazing and we appreciate the help we receive from our donors and sponsors each year. Thank you for helping all those amazing kids and we hope to see you next year.
