Dr. Keri Topouzian was born and raised in Detroit, Michigan where he currently lives with his wife and four children while practicing medicine in both Grand Rapids and Detroit. His grandparents hailed from Ancient Armenia, each immigrating to the U.S. in the early 1900's.


Topouzian started writing "A Perfect Armenian" in 2003 and published the novel 7 years later. As a boy, his mother, a journalist, would critique all of his school papers with a discerning eye until they were perfect. Later in life he realized this was a blessing in disguise. His love of writing was further developed while preparing elaborate proposals for a medical document transcription company he had once owned. He found through this business that he enjoyed taking abstract ideas and putting them to paper.

Topouzian's first novel is rooted in the history of his own grandparents and the extraordinary lives they were forced to lead during World War I. His grandparents hailed from four different villages in Ancient Armenia (now part of Turkey), each immigrating separately to the United States. Keri's paternal grandmother, Varsenig, came from the village of Tchingiler, a city that is an integral part of "A Perfect Armenian". In 1915, Turkish soldiers forced Varsenig, her family and the rest of their village to walk from their homes to the desert near Damascus, Syria. They walked hundreds of miles because the soldiers had convinced the villagers that they were traveling to safety from World War I. They were deprived of food and water, and left to die. 1.5 million Armenians were killed in the genocide.

While most books about Armenian history tend to disclose the dark victimization that plagued this people, the Topouzian chose to focus on the victories hidden within this extraordinary time, and to emphasize the heartbreaking choices that can make real life victories possible.

#### **Tavid Kaloustian**

Tavid Kaloustain is a walking contradiction. Even as a young man, he is devoted to his family and natural born killer. He cares about his own welfare, as well as that of those he loves, yet he grows, deals, and imbibes in opium. He loves deeply, yet has a red hot rage toward his captors and the way they treat his people. As he embarks on the adventures of his life, he feels alive, and yet alone, so he finds and makes unusual friends. He would give his life for his friends, his grandfather trained him to protect them. But if you cross him, you will not only be sorry, you will lose your life.

#### Kalkim Bay

Kalkim Bay has been in the Turkish military for most of his life. He is charming, ruthless, and cunning, qualities he has used well to advance his career. At 40 years old, he rose to the rank of Captain in the Ottoman Army, after his superior officer turned up dead. Most people fear Kalkim Bay and his lust for power. All but Tavid, who understands this tall, dark man's weakness for opium.

#### **Tahir Bay**

Though his father, Kalkim, wishes that Tahir would follow in his footsteps, Tahir finds the military distasteful and does not share his father's lust for power. Tahir does share, however, an odd friendship with Tavid, despite their external front of hatred.


#### Karoun Eftendelian

This young women is more than a sixteen year old girl, she is the future wife whom Tavid's grandfather had chosen for him. Karoun's family has mixed feelings about Tavid, however, especially her father, who does not agree with Tavid's approach to the ruling Turks. Karoun was home schooled and works in the family restaurant, but has a mind of her own and shows it.

#### **Anoush Kaloustian**

Widowed, still young at 37, and the loving mother of three, Tavid's mother, Anoush, has lived in Tchingiler for her entire life. She keeps a clean two room home as well as a high moral standard, however, the other villagers see her and her family, as "different." Her father, Yervant, became a father figure to Tavid until his death a year before our story begins.




