

Paradise Point Swing Mooring Relocation

International Coastal Management was commissioned by Salacia Waters, to obtain approval from Maritime Safety Queensland (MSQ) for the relocation of swing moorings adjacent to the site of their proposed marina.

A preliminary survey was undertaken to assess the location and condition of the existing moorings. Relocation of 20 moorings was required to facilitate safe access and acceptable fairways to the new marina in accordance with Australian Standards. Potential relocation sites and potential mooring reconfiguration were developed and approved by MSQ.

ICM developed design drawings and tender documentation to facilitate the tender process on behalf of the client. Supervision of the mooring relocation and final location survey was undertaken by ICM for approval by MSQ.
