Summer Projects - Modernization

In exciting news, and after lots of work, Dunham is going to be receiving approximately \$1 million for modernization. The initial phases of the project will begin this summer and include new HVAC, fire alarm, carpeting/flooring in some spaces, and internal painting. Because we are receiving modernization funds, the monies will only impact the main "H" portion of our campus.

Rainwater Catchment Project

Dunham's Rainwater Catchment Project is underway! A few pieces of equipment/machinery will be very helpful for the success of this project.

The tractor will be used to scrape the ground to create a flat platform for the gravel foundation. We will use a thick layer of gravel for the foundation. The tank will be set on the gravel foundation. The backhoe will be used to dig the trench for the irrigation tube going out to the pumpkin patch.
