*Frontline Services (Formerly MHS). staff will provide an overview of Coordinated Intake and Permanent Supportive Housing and how to access these units.

*Housing Research and Advocacy Center will provide information on fair housing laws and how to assert your rights under the law.

*Dept. of Veterans Affairs staff will talk about their housing related services.
