To access every publicly funded shelter in the community, you **must** complete a central intake application. You can get a referral to 2100 Lakeside, Y-Haven, Harbor Light, PASS, City Mission, Family Promise, Laura's Home, West Side Catholic, and VOA shelters from Coordinated Intake. After hours and weekends: men go to 2100 Lakeside – women go to 2227 Payne Ave – Families call 2-1-1 or use callbox at the Coordinated Intake site to get a shelter bed.
