Please find enclosed a copy of the report of Baseline Water Resource Inc. (BWRI) of residential water and free gas sampling dated May 29, 2013 (BWRI Report) and accompanying certificate of analysis performed for BWRI by ALS Environmental (Certificate). The BWRI Report and Certificate outline the procedures utilized and results of the April 3, 2013 testing of your water well at SE-18-043-27W4 (GIC#0078001).

As per our February 5, 2013 letter, the ERCB testing of your water well was similar in nature to testing conducted in 2012. The purpose of the testing has been to monitor your water well over a number of years in order to detect any change in groundwater chemical quality. The ERCB's review of the BWRI Report found the test results and findings do not differ substantially from previous test results. Furthermore, the results of the 2013 testing support and confirm our previous conclusion that there is no evidence of a link between energy development activities and the hydrocarbon or H₂S gases present in your water well.

In conclusion, the results of the 2013 and past exhaustive and extensive testing conducted on behalf of the ERCB in connection with the investigation have consistently shown no evidence of a link between the gas present in your water well and oil and gas activities in the area. As such, the ERCB's investigation has been concluded and we are now proceeding to close our file in this matter. We would like to thank you for your assistance throughout.
