Rolex times out TV ads

This week brings the Masters – our preview begins on page 10 – and the uncommon concept of few commercials crowding out the purpose of the television broadcast. That's a Masters tradition on CBS that, until the Players Championship copied it a few years ago, truly was unlike any other.

Not any more. Beginning this year, most USGA telecasts on Fox and its companion FS1 cable network will have no commercials beyond billboards for watchmaker Rolex.

The USGA and Fox struck a multi-year deal with the Swiss timing giant to underwrite the broadcasts with a bare minimum of mentions, except for the U.S. Open, where the plan of the first three years on Fox – commercials until the last hour – will still be in effect.

But even the U.S. Women's Open, this year's first Fox golfcast, will be effectively commercial-free. Rolex will sponsor occasional golf-related promotional announcements to give the broadcast crew a breather.

Now, if someone could get the PGA of America to do the same for the PGA Championship, perhaps there would be as much golf on CBS that week as there will be this week.

New caddie push by WGA: "Carry the Game" is the name of a new initiative focusing on promoting youth caddieing led by the Western Golf Association.

It's described as an advocacy group introducing young students to golf by creating additional opportunities for them to train and work as caddies and encour-

ages them to become lifelong players.

In addition to being a great way to learn about the game, caddieing provides life-changing benefits that are instrumental to their individual growth.

Participants in the effort include the World Golf Foundation, United States Golf Association, PGA of America, The First Tee and Youth on Course.

"Over the past few years, numerous leading golf organizations have discussed the importance of creating a governing body for youth caddieing, and we're excited to see that the WGA is spearheading this important initiative," said World Golf Foundation CEO **Steve Mona**. "We're all looking forward to working together to help bring this effort to life."

The overall goal of Carry the Game is to increase the number of youth caddies – and the diversity of those caddies – by helping to establish additional caddie opportunities at golf clubs nationwide. Carry the Game will also promote youth caddie programs as a way to create future golfers and preserve and enhance the tradition of caddieing within the game of golf.

It will offer resources including caddie training materials and certification, best practices on creating and managing programs, and knowledge and expertise on all caddie-related topics.

"Through Carry the Game, our goal is to provide young people with an early introduction to golf by creating life-changing opportunities to work as a caddie," said WGA president and CEO John Kaczkowski.

The return of singular brilliance

n this space a year ago, it was written:

"A back so bad that you can't play, can't practice, some days can't get out of bed, means there's no chance to return and play even middling golf on a regular basis."

Those words were, of course, written about Tiger Woods.

Oops. It appears our physicians' license has expired. Against all odds, and even after a pill-induced DUI that found him slumped in his car by a Florida highway, Tiger Woods is back.

That is, Tiger Woods is back because his back is back.

Mended. Fused, actually, in the type of operation a handful of hockey players have had over the years to permit them to return to the rink.

After three microdiscectomies to rid himself of pain and allow him to both walk and swing a club, and a poorer result each time, Woods went for the bundle.

Gary Barnett, whose coaching took Northwestern to an undefeated Big Ten season and the 1996 Rose Bowl, often spoke of the difference between a risk and a gamble. A risk, Barnett said, was taking a chance you believed had a great chance of paying off. A gamble was just that, playing long odds with little chance of a payoff.

Woods, after three risks that failed, took a gamble.

It paid off.

So far in his return, at least, Woods not only walks without pain, he can swing the same way,

and as the weeks have gone by, the novelty of seeing him back on a golf course has been replaced by a sense of wonder.

First, for some of us, for the work the doctors did. Then for his ability to return mechanically to a swing that served him well in the past.

Finally, in his recent starts, that he's been competitive once again. A threat. A birdie machine.

The one thing Woods hasn't been able to accomplish yet is to finish the job. To sink the birdie putt when necessary, or hit the big approach that cozies up to the cup and allows an eagle to fly.

But the progression has been as steady as it has been unexpected given the long string stops and false starts since his victory on a broken leg – to this point the most amazing success of his career – at Torrey Pines in the 2008 U.S. Open.

A decade ago. When he was 32 and, presuming good health, the future was still bright.

If that progression continues this week at Augusta National, if Woods contends, it will prove to all of us who thought he was finished that we were wrong.

If the progression accelerates and he wins the 82nd Masters, garnering an 18th major championship to close to within two of Jack Nicklaus, then the man who for the last few years has been merely an old Tiger will be the Tiger of old.

He's the betting favorite – 9/1 on many Las Vegas odds boards – because casinos love looting their customers. But if he wins at Augusta, handles those steep hills, handles the surgeon'stouch chips that cause others to buckle and the baby's breath putts across and down slopes that he's previously gauged with frightening regularity, then he'd be a legitimate favorite for any tournament as long as he's healthy.

Just like before.

There are, of course, two differences between the Woods of 2008 and the Woods of 2018.

One is the additional decade on his body. Leave aside his back for a moment. His knees have been operated on more than anyone this side of Bobby Orr. Those delicate hinges could cause more trouble at any time.

The other is the depth of the field he'll face in any given week. Dustin Johnson, Rory Mc-Ilroy, Jordan Spieth, Justin Thomas, Jason Day and Bubba Watson were rumors a decade ago. Oh, and Phil Mickelson pulled one foot out of the career grave and stepped back into the winner's circle a few weeks ago.

Woods can no longer step on a practice tee and intimidate a field.

That's great. Competition is always preferable to a parade when the Masters begins on the back nine on Sunday. If Woods is in the mix a few more times the next few years, hurrah. If not, it's pleasing to see that his health will allow him to go out on his own terms.

DICK NUGENT, 1931-2018 A creative old-school designer

ick Nugent didn't like to sit still in his work.


A golf-course architect, he could have stayed with the tried and true, as did his mentor, Robert Bruce Harris, who churned out course after course with similar maintenance-efficient features for years.

Nugent couldn't do that. First with fellow designer Ken Killian – also from the Harris stable – then on his own, and finally with son Tim, Dick Nugent was a restlessly creative force who conjured up some of the best golf courses to be played.

Some, like Kemper Lakes in its first decades and close cousin George Dunne National, and the 36-hole Harborside International complex on Chicago's southeast side, were open to the public. Others were private playgrounds, including the nine-hole Dunes Club in New Buffalo, Mich., which many consider the finest nine-hole layout on the planet.

All were interesting, worth a multiple plays.

Nugent died on New Year's Day, at 86. A member of the Illinois Golf Hall of Fame, Nugent had retired to Sun Lake, Ariz., some 15 years before, concluding a career that began as an assistant to Harris soon after graduating from Illinois with a landscape architecture degree in 1958. That came after transferring from John Carroll in

Cleveland, where he played college football with Don Shula before two years in the Navy.

He also played a bit of football at Illinois, but reshaping grass, not blocking and tackling on it, was his future. And the future of the game in architecture is what Nugent became known for.

"He preferred big scale and not much subtlety," said architect Jeff Brauer, who started in Nugent's office. "If you study the history of the Chicago School, or post WW II architecture in general, where they were anxious to move on and not respect the past, given how bad it was in nearly every respect, they developed the new American style."

It was carried both to new courses and to those he renovated, Brauer noted.

"He reminded me often that we probably do more for golf by designing a good green for some rural course than building a big budget course for high dollar players," Brauer said.

"Dick was the professional equivalent of my own father. He was a teacher, and I learned nearly all I know about golf course architecture from him. Certainly, no one was better technically.

"My first day in the office (in 1977) he gave me a par 3 to design on one of the many Chicago area renovations they did," Brauer recalled. "I put a pond in front of the green. He saw it, grunted and walked back in his office. I figured I would be fired after one day, but it turned out he was deep in thought. A few hours later he came back and explained that they tried a forced carry par 3 (similar to Baltusrol's fourth hole) and women and seniors complained about it, so he preferred to keep at least some fairway opening to the green."

Nugent was a former president of the American Society of Golf Course Architects.

"I last saw him at the beginning of 2017 and we spoke about organizing a lunch roundtable with some ASGCA members here in Arizona," said Forrest Richardson, another former ASGCA president. "I wish we had managed the lunch as it was going to be taped for prosperity."

Brent Wadsworth, 1929-2018 He built an empire from the dirt

rent Wadsworth worked with his hands. He may have eventually commanded an army of tractors, Bobcats and other earth moving implements, but it all started with a shovel or two and elbow grease.

Wadsworth, a member of the Illinois Golf Hall of Fame whose founding of the golf course construction company bearing his name in 1958 revolutionized an industry, died Tue., Feb. 6 at his home in Yorkville. He was 88.

His Plainfield-based company began with small local projects, and eventually expanded to cover the world. Whether it was a new course or a revitalized version of an old one, Wadsworth was the company to call, and remains so.

For a time, Wadsworth and partner Larry Packard combined golf course architecture with construction, but soon settled on building what others, including Packard, had envisioned. A graduate of Illinois' landscape architecture school, he worked for Robert Bruce Harris prior to the Korean War, and after it went his own well-manicured path.

The company has had a hand in the construction of over 900 courses worldwide.

More than once, Wadsworth spent more than was budgeted to do it right, and never sent an extra bill.

That detail work earned more business than

penny-pinching would have increased profits.

Wadsworth's painstaking belief in getting it right also attracted high-visibility clients.

When downpours turned Rae's Creek into a raging torrent one winter, officials of Augusta National Golf Club called Wadsworth, and within weeks, the 11th and 12th greens had been rebuilt precisely as they had been.

Under his tenure, the firm also built Shadow Creek near Las Vegas from scratch. Closer to home, Wadsworth built Wedgewood Golf Course in his boyhood home of Joliet, Cantigny Golf in Wheaton, and dozens of other courses, including the recent reconstruction of the Preserve at Oak Meadows.

A more important legacy may be the foundation he created to build youth courses and grow the game that way. The first was a four-hole layout behind Lockport Township High School's East campus.

More recently, the "Links Across America" concept features convertible courses with multiple tees so kids can play with their parents. Grants have also gone to youth golf organizations from coast to coast.

Wadsworth was also generous personally, especially to Joliet-area causes. He was behind the rebirth of the Rialto Square Theatre, founded a scholarship fund in his name for Joliet grade school students, and once surprised Joliet Township High School Foundation president Mark Turk at a meeting.

"I was expecting \$100," Turk recalled to the Joliet Herald-News. "He handed me the check, and I just about fell over because it was a \$25,000 check.

"He wanted to help anybody in any way he could, not just monetarily but with vision. The world's going to miss someone like Brent. There are very few people like him."

He is survived by Jean Wadsworth, children Stanley, Leslie Loague, Martha Grimm and Eric, two grandchildren, and sister Betty Jones.

2017 IN REVIEW The year of the double-double

Twin titles by Flavin, Schumacher, Ghim's Am run highlighted 2017

atrick Flavin was just another name on the tee sheet at the start of last year's Illinois Amateur. He'd had some nice finishes, but so had many others.

By the end of the tournament at Calumet Country Club, he was holding the trophy in his hands, the result of splendid play over 54 holes.

And a couple of weeks later, this time at The Glen Club, he was holding the Illinois Open trophy aloft, the first player to capture both state titles in the same year since David Ogrin did so in 1980. Flavin opened with a pair of 64 at Briarwood and The Glen Club, then hung on to beat a trio of players by a stroke.

Ogrin went on to have a fine professional career. Flavin, who ran together a string of college victories representing Miami (Ohio) in the fall, hopes to emulate that.

He's off to the right start, and was one of the standout players in Illinois in 2017.

Another was Adam Schumacher, an assistant pro at Indian Hill Club, who scored his own double in the weeks following Flavin's. Schumacher scored a three-stroke victory in the Illinois PGA at Medinah Country Club, and followed that up by beating them again in the Illinois Players Championship at Eagle Ridge Resort in Galena,

outlasting Andy Mickelson of Mistwood Golf Club in a three-hole playoff.

The year's most dominating performance came in the IHSA's boys 2A championship, where Morton standout Tommy Kuhl won the high school title by 12 strokes by shooting 13-under 129 across two rounds at Weibring Golf Course in Normal, with his opening-round 8-under 63 a record for any IHSA competition.

Then there was Doug Ghim of Arlington Heights. He didn't make appreciable noise at the NCAA Championship at Rich Harvest Farms or in the Western Amateur at Skokie Country Club.

But a fortnight later, at the U.S. Amateur at Riviera Country Club, Ghim went to town, plowing through match-play foes until he found himself in the title match against Doc Redman of Raleigh, N.C., who had bowed to Norman Xiong in the Western Am title match.

Forced to the limit, Redman outlandishly went eagle-birdie on the 17th and 18th holes at Riviera to force extra holes, and then birdied that hole, the famed short 10th, to wrest the Havemeyer Trophy out of Ghim's grasp.

Said Steve Elkington, who won the 1995 PGA at Riviera, "incredible finish. (N)obody finishes 3, 3 at Riv to force a playoff."

Said Ghim, "I did the absolute best I could have. I put (Redman) in the position he was under

the hot seat, and he just thrived under it."

Ghim's consolation prizes weren't bad. He, like Redman, made the Walker Cup team, and both are in this week's Masters Tournament. He's also the Illinois Golfer **Player of the Year**.

Outside the ropes, most of the year's major developments involved real estate. Renovations began at several courses, notably Sunset Valley in Highland Park (see page 16), while the concept of rebuilding the Jackson Park and South Shore courses on Chicago's south side was broached and met with questions from the community and beyond (see page 14), slowing a brisk timetable to a crawl, those questions and the cost casting the future of the project in doubt.

Additionally, in a deal marking a reuniting after a century, the Women's Western Golf Association will work in conjunction with the Western

Golf Association for tournament and scholarship operations, with the handover beginning late this year.

The year was also marked by the loss of several of the state's golf leaders:

- **John Barney**, 90, who with wife Joan founded the Illinois Junior Golf Association, March 16:
- **Jim Ashenden**, 92, former WGA president, March 18;
- Chuck Austin, 68, longtime John Deere Classic volunteer killed in an on-course accident at TPC Deere Run, July 7;
- **Roger Packard**, 70, golf course architect whose designs include Cantigny Golf, Oct. 14;
- and Carol McCue, 94, innovative former executive director of the Chicago District Golf Association, and mentor to many, Dec. 16.

She had begun to play golf shortly before, and, encouraged by Frank, got into the game so well, she won several club championships and scored under 70 numerous times. She was also a gardening whiz, and, as anyone who knew her knew, doted on her children.

Patricia Brown was born November 20, 1944 in Lake Forest, while her father was a dentist at Great Lakes Naval Station. After his time in the Navy, Pat's parents, Ted and Odessa Brown, moved back to New Orleans to raise their family.

Pat spent her childhood in New Orleans, graduating from Mt. Carmel Academy in 1961.

Along with Frank, she is survived by three children, Marla Weeks (and husband Kevin), Katherine Jemsek, and Joe Jemsek (and wife Meredith); four grandchildren, Patricia and Brooke Weeks and Sawyer and Noa Jemsek; and sisters Bonnie Montgomery and Cindy Booth.

Major attractions on tap

Senior Players, inaugural U.S. Senior Women's coming to Chicago area

o say Chicago's golf calendar is crowded this year the obvious. A glance at the chart of the Big Seven on the following page has no room for a pair of nearby senior tournaments: the Senior PGA Championship at nearby Harbor Shores in Benton Harbor, Mich., on Memorial Day weekend and the 50plus shindig hosted by Steve Stricker at University Ridge in Madison, Wis., on June 22-24.

Nor does it include the significant course openings at Sand Valley in Nekoosa, Wis. Yes, that is correctly plural, for Mike Keiser's latest brainchild grows from 18 to 53 holes this year, with the Sandbox, a 17-hole par-3 course designed by Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw opening May 1, and Mammoth Dunes, the vision of David McLay Kidd – Keiser's original designer at Bandon Dunes - commencing full operation on May 31.

Plus, the Preserve at Oak Meadows, the Addison showplace of the DuPage County Forest Preserve District, which opened late last year, will be open for the full season, as detailed on page 16, Sunset Valley in Highland Park reopens later in the year after a similarly large-scale renovation.

While the BMW Championship is in Philadelphia this year, the ticket-buying golf fan, and the one at home lolling on the couch, will have a

quandary in mid-July, for three big tournaments, all worth a look, will take place in northern Illinois in the same week.

The 48th rendition of the John Deere Classic will, as always, be at TPC Deere Run in Silvis, where the Quad Cities faithful not only turn out in good numbers, but punch well above their weight when it comes to giving back to charity.

The Deere's same-week competition in the

Chicago market is stout. For starters, there's a first: the United States Golf Association's inaugural Senior Women's Open. Once considered a fantasy, and realistic more recently, this July 12-15 the dream of Legends Tour founder Jane Blalock comes to fruition with the USGA's backing.

Knowing they needed a strong opening act, the USGA managed to get Chicago Golf Club, where the doors rarely open widely, to host. That

is a coup, as anyone who was on the grounds for the 2005 Walker Cup will recall. The attendance for the two-day U.S. vs. Britain friendly greatly surpassed what club and USGA brass expected, for the simple reason that almost everyone who turned out wanted to see the golf course.

For those who have only one day to spectate, Chicago Golf is be the place to be. For those with multiple days, one of them should be a trip to the third candidate for viewing, Exmoor Country Club in Highland Park, which like Chicago Golf hasn't hosted pros in generations. Exmoor, a Donald Ross redesign, landed the Constellation Senior Players Championship. As the name hints, it's considered a major on the over-50 men's tour. That makes for two senior men's majors within driving distance – the Senior PGA at Harbor Shores is the other – and only seven weeks apart.

This bounty of brilliance has another double-whammy week at the end of June, when the KPMG Women's PGA Championship – the LPGA Championship in its first incarnation – camps at Kemper Lakes Golf Club in Kildeer. Danielle Kang won last year's edition at Olympia Fields, and Kemper members expect to greatly surpass the sparse crowds at the south suburban facility.

However, the WPGA will have competition from the Women's Western Amateur. One of the major indicators of future professional excellence – winners include Stacy Lewis and Nancy Lopez – will be played the same week at Mistwood Golf Club in Romeoville. The amateur match-play championship, second only to the U.S. Women's Amateur in prestige on this continent, wraps up with a 36-hole finale on Saturday, June 30, with the pros finishing at Kemper Lakes the following day, so it's possible for the aficionado to take in two trophy presentations in as many days.

he reasons Masters week is the most anticipated golf week of the year are numerous, and warranted.

It's the first men's major championship of the year. The annual peek at flowery Augusta National Golf Club does wonders in prodding those thinking this will be the year the landscape around the house gets a makeover. Plus, Spring is arriving in the north – though the temperature of 15 degrees at Illinois Golfer headquarters at 6 a.m. on Mon., April 2 makes one believe the Chicago calendar has an extra February in it. Azaleas in this town would never stand a chance.

This year, there's something more. It's difficult to remember a recent Masters where so many top players are at their peak, or close to it. Look at the batting order:

- Bubba Watson, who has a pair of Masters titles, has won twice, first in the Los Angeles Open at Riviera Country Club and more recently in the WGC Match Play in Austin, Tex.
- Rory McIlroy returned to form with a victory in the Arnold Palmer Invitational.
- Phil Mickelson, something of a novelty given his winless streak since his British Open title, stormed through the field to win at the WGC Mexico Championship.
- Justin Thomas beat all who poked their heads into the tent at the Honda Classic.
- Jason Day bombed his way to the title at Torrey Pines in San Diego.
- Jon Rahm triumphed in Palm Springs at what traditionalists still call the Bob Hope Desert Classic.
- Dustin Johnson, who rolls down Magnolia Lane still No. 1 in the world ranking, opened the year properly by winning the Tournament of Champions.
- and to add sauce to the stew, Ian Poulter jumped into the Masters field by grabbing the final available spot, thanks to his playoff victory in Sunday's Houston Open.

Throw in two other names for good measure



and to make the A-list pool picks complete:

- Jordan Spieth, the 2015 Masters champion and 2016 goat who handed a green jacket to Danny Willett, winless since capturing last year's British Open, but a threatening joint third in Houston, where three rounds in the 60s showed he may have his recalcitrant putting stroke in order.
- and Tiger Woods, the wild-card selection given his remarkable recovery from spinal-fusion surgery. The range of motion he exhibits in his swing, plus the familiar power of days gone by, belies the idea that he's restricted in any way. With a second at Innisbrook and a fifth at Bay Hill, along with a tie for 12th at the Honda Classic, Woods has shown that even a game rusty from years of barely playing is formidable. Those three recent outings and his course knowledge at Augusta National four victories, his last 13 years

ago, and three fourth-place ties this decade, the most recent in 2014 – install him as a contender.

Who do you like? One of those 10 is likely to win, but it could be someone else.

Why not Paul Casey, who beat a stellar field at Innisbrook, his first win anywhere in four years, three weeks ago? He's ranked 13th in the world, is playing as well as anyone and, with nine top-10 finishes in majors and a tie for sixth and solo fourth and sixth the last three years in the Masters, is due to break through in one of the four weeks each year people will remember.

The story lines attendant the above-named are obvious. Here are just four:

- A Woods victory at age 42 would be an earthshaking development and set him back on the path of surpassing Jack Nicklaus as the game's greatest player.
- A Mickelson title, which would be his fourth at Augusta, would tie him with Palmer and Woods in Masters wins, give him seven career majors Illinois Golfer counts his U.S. Amateur title, as it does those of Nicklaus, Woods and everyone else and point him toward Shinnecock Hills and the U.S. Open as a realistic possibility, even at the golf-advanced age of 47.
- A McIlroy success would earn him a career grand slam at the tender age of 28, and more than make up for his improbable implosion on the back

tance," but the results were reversed. He belted his first drive 229.1 yards, and his second 219. The longer drive counted. His chips weren't close at 17 feet 4 inches and 23-7, but he rebounded with a pair of putts to 1 foot 7 inches and 1-11 to finish fifth in putting.

• And if Dustin Johnson wins, it would be a fitting rebound from 2017, where he arrived as the favorite and never teed it up thanks to slipping on stairs and injuring his back at his rental house.

All of the above has pushed the black-market prices for Masters tickets – both the daily admissions, largely restricted to the three practice-round days, where the mood is casual and one can bring a camera – and the tournament badges, which cover the four days of competition, to highs not seen since Woods was last a real factor.

One online site dealing in the precious ducats quoted \$2,480 as the lowest price for access to

Thursday's round. Bargain-hunters may want to buy a Saturday or Sunday ticket, at \$2,100 each.

Other sites are higher, with \$3,500 and more seen for a Thursday entry.

For the week? If you have \$6,200 you want to get rid of, Stubhub will take it, as of Monday morning. That's down from around \$9,400 last week. And a ticket to Wednesday's practice round and Par-3 Contest, the most fun day of the week, will set you back at least \$538.

The way ticket brokers work their game, the season badge, if bought for a day, has to be returned after the day's play, or a stiff fee is slapped on your credit card.

Augusta National's list price for the few actual daily tickets for tournament days are \$115 each, while practice round tickets are \$75. In both cases they're a bargain, and the \$325 rate for the four-day badge is a bargain squared.

But worry not for the club, which also sells lunch and drinks at 1980s prices. It makes up for it in merchandise sales, and this year has opened a lavish new facility, twice as large as the old one. It has 64 cashiers. Think the madness of Black Friday at Walmart at 6 a.m. for a full week, 10 hours a day, and it's clear that not only the jackets and grass at Augusta National is green.

Those fortunate enough to be there – probably

45,000 on a practice day, and about 40,000 on tournament days – have a grand experience, a throwback in that Augusta still bans cellular telephones on the grounds. So nobody will be taking pictures or video or texting when they could be watching golf, as is the case at every other tournament these days. Sneak a cell phone into Augusta National, and you're out on your ear.

While the punishment is excessive, the notion of coming to a sports event to see the sports event is quaintly proper. Augusta didn't invent the manual scoreboard – even Clifford Roberts, who ruled with an iron hand for the club's first 45 years, admitted he stole the idea from baseball, where once every park had a scoreboard akin to Wrigley Field's – but it perfected it. Scores go up quickly, quietly, and without a drum roll.

There are no video screens at Augusta National, not even in concession areas. If there were, fans would linger rather than chow down – one can eat lunch three times, plus have a must-have ice cream sandwich, and still get change back from \$20 – and return to the course.

This simplicity of attraction – marvel at the course, see the golf, enjoy the atmosphere – plus the scarcity of tickets means not only are spectators on their best

behavior, they largely buy into the concept that an undistracted walk in a golf garden is a wonderful thing. They like being considered patrons, as in a patron of the arts. They like being pampered, whether it's the quick concessions service or knowing that even the restrooms have attendants. And those who are fortunate enough to indulge in visiting Berckman's Place, the ultraplush hospitality area to the right of the fifth fairway with a 90,000square foot clubhouse of its own and replica putting greens to test one's skill, really love it. (A ticket is \$6,000 for the week, sold to corporations in blocks of 10, and rarely shows up in a broker's hand.)

CBS's television coverage of Augusta, presented with few commercials and an abundance of verbal gushing over the whole operation, has built the image of the club and the tournament as much as what the club has done itself over the years.

Lingering shots of flora and fauna, the Dave Loggins tune, and the extreme manicuring of the course itself, down to workers clipping grass at the edges of bunkers with scissors, help create the incentive to jump into the ticket lottery for a chance to walk the grounds and buy hats, shirts and tchotchkes for family and friends.

It all works. Cue the azaleas.



About half of the \$60 million will be to construct a pair of underpasses on streets that cut through the golf course in both the present and revised routings, Kelly said.

"Whether we get this golf course or not, the underpasses need to happen," Kelly said, citing the safety aspect of installing them under Jeffery Blvd. in the middle of the courses, under 67th St. on the east end, and potentially, a third under Hayes Dr. for easier access to the practice range. That would raise the cost another \$1.5 million to \$2 million, Kelly explained.

Kelly wouldn't put a timetable on any aspect of the project, except to note that once construction began, it would take at least 18 months, depending on the time of year it began. A year ago, he said groundbreaking would occur last spring.

Instead, the past year has been one for listing to community members both compliment and complain about the plan. The changes were presented to a group of about 300 people Wed., Jan. 31 at the South Shore Cultural Center. The largest applause for any feature was for the revised and expanded nature sanctuary, the removal of which in the original plan caused great consternation.

The current 5.5 acre area adjacent to Lake Michigan will be retained in part – with a green on the peninsula occupying most of it – and expanded to a total of 11.5 acres under the revised routing by course architect Beau Welling, the lead designer of Tiger Woods' design company.

Additionally, the closing of Marquette Rd. has been mitigated somewhat by the allowance of a bike and jogging path along the same route.

But the price tag is still huge, and Kelly admits the money isn't there at the moment, one rea-

son – along with permitting and final adjustments – there's no timetable for construction.

The concept, originally sold as being an answer to a 2000 survey, has been folded into a larger concept called the South Lakefront Framework Plan, one including more natural habitat areas.

The west side of the golf course has been largely rerouted, with a new golf clubhouse on at 67th and Jeffrey, and the course starting and ending there rather than its current location near 63rd St. on Richards Ave. That current clubhouse, named after Cecil Partee, will be used for the short course and the youth golf programs planned in conjunction with the rebuild.

"We have returning nines now," Welling said. "That makes perfect sense."

Welling noted his original plan didn't have that, and that the regulars used to playing nine at South Shore complained.

"By shifting the clubhouse, we achieve that, though it's the 10th hole that returns to the clubhouse," he said.

The new plan includes a third lake on the course, adding a dramatic approach to the fourth hole and the entirety of the par-5 fifth.

In his original plan, the final four holes played alongside fencing on 67th and then Cornell Dr. Now, the 15th through 17th holes are along the lakefront, behind the South Shore Cultural Center – the old clubhouse for South Shore Country Club – with the par-5 18th returning along 67th to Jeffrey, and a lake on the right side of the fairway similar to the par-4 16th at Kemper Lakes.

"The 15th hole, playing out to the point with the view of the Chicago skyline in the distance is going to be that kind of a (picturesque) hole," Welling said. "We don't really believe in signature holes, but I think that will be the one people will talk about. It's really the start of the finish of the round."

If the BMW Championship or another pro tournament is played there, the final four holes are a 3-5-3-5 combination, with the tee shot on the 545-yard par-5 16th over the beach at the South Shore complex. Regular customers would play it as a 365-yard par-4.

The yardages of the par-70 course would range from 2,998 to 7,161 yards, and as a 7,341-yard par-71 layout in tournament play.

"The transition of the three pieces of property are going to create a very different kind of experience," Welling said. "You go from a very urban feel to kind of out to the lake and then you kind of come back in. I think it's going to be something that's really unique and special. We're excited about it all."

Kelly made a curious analogy during both a news conference and the public presentation, noting the current Jackson Park layout had narrower fairways than Oakmont Country Club, and that South Shore had smaller greens than those at Pebble Beach.

He neglected to note that Jackson Park is much shorter than Oakmont, and South Shore is effectively a par-3 course with a couple of longer holes, thus mitigating the need for larger greens.

People seemed pleased, with many asking Kelly and Welling questions of their own following the formal presentation, but not everyone liked what they heard.

"I don't want an amusement park," one resident told a WBBM-AM reporter.

North Shore golf in flux

Sunset Valley reopening, Highland Park closes, and Lake Bluff's future is in doubt

year after the private Green Acres Country Club closed because of financial distress, the public golf scene on the north shore is changing – and may change further.

The center of the change is in Highland Park. That leafy lakeside suburb has had two public golf courses for years, but this year, they'll be down to one.

Sunset Valley Golf Club, closed for a complete rebuild last year, will reopen in the summer. But Highland Park Country Club, which became a public venue in 1993 after years as a private club, closed at the end of 2017, and, unless a group's last-ditch effort to keep some of the course open is accepted by the village, is closed forever, with redevelopment as a park planned.

Nearby, the village of Lake Bluff is wrestling with what to do with Lake Bluff Golf Course, their municipal layout. Like Highland Park, it's been running in the red for several years.

Here's a closer look at the three courses:

Sunset Valley GC

A \$7 million rebuild, including a new clubhouse, short game area and maintenance center, will be completed by July, the original Stewart Gardner layout re-imagined by Rick Jacobson in the same corridors, but with significant tree removal and a good deal of elevation changes built in to what's being called a remake in the style of a

British highlands course. The course is expected to reopen late in the summer to allow for proper grow-in.

The big redo came about after the park district, which conceived of the course in 1919, and the village, which owned Highland Park Country Club but was leasing it to the district, decided to keep only one course open and settled on Sunset Valley – after some considerable discussion, said Illinois Golf Hall of Famer Joel Hirsch, who took

up the game at Sunset Valley.

"Sunset Valley is in the center of Highland Park," Hirsch noted. "Highland Park Country Club is on the far north side. So all the kids growing up like me today, it was a long bike ride for me, but Highland Park would be twice as long. It would be good for the kids who live north, but it wouldn't be fair to the kids who live west and south and east. ... (T)hey had the money and decided if they were going to keep one course open,

it was going to be a knock your socks off kind of course."

Hirsch saw Jacobson's plan, has visited during construction, and thinks the recreation will live up to expectation. He's so enthusiastic, he's a major contributor to the new foundation that will help support the course.

The fourth hole is supposed to be a dandy, with a peninsula green designed to provide not only a lovely vista, but a difficult approach shot.

Highland Park CC

The city took over the private course in 1993, a \$10 million investment that has cost much more since. The park district took over operation of the course in 2015, and losses escalated, while Sunset Valley, which was losing money earlier in the decade, turned its finances around. The current plan is to create a 100-acre park – doubling as a flood plain – with walking trails as well as a lake. The course's driving range and miniature golf course would be retained, while the clubhouse could become part of the adjacent recreation center.

But mid-March saw a surprise proposal at a park board meeting. Former park district commissioner David Fairman advanced a plan calling for a six-hole practice course as well as a putting course and children's practice area. He called it "The Golf Mecca."

"Facilities, technology and programs will be designed to introduce new participants to the game, providing year-round practice facilities for the avid golfer, while maintaining a select few golf holes for on-course instruction," Fairman explained.

Architect David Esler and Highland Park financier Keith Bank are the other principals behind the plan, which includes indoor golf simulators for year-round operation.

If that plan – a longshot because of the timing – is accepted, the six-hole course would be adjacent to a condo development that was built several years ago. More than a few residents there objected to the closing of the course, saying the redevelopment into a park would bring too much foot traffic to the area.

For now, there's no golf at what was Highland Park Country Club.

Lake Bluff GC

Opened in the fall of 1968, some of it on a previously swampy flood plain, Lake Bluff Golf Course, created through the prodding and hard work of residents Richard Surkamer and William McCormick Blair, has been a jewel in the community adjacent to Lake Forest for all the years since. But what once was called Rockland Park Golf Course been losing money for the village's park district in recent years, and officials have all but given up on turning the numbers around.

They say a needed renovation of the club-house and repairs to the course – investments that would total \$3.7 million over the next dozen years

- would put them further in the red.

"The past and future golf financials are daunting," park district executive director Ron Salski said at a meeting on Feb. 26. "Eventually the board needs to make some decisions."

As is the case nationally, rounds played have declined since the Great Recession, dropping about 18 percent to around 26,000 from nearly 31,500 in 2007. That's created an accumulated loss of over \$3 million since then.

The course, bisected by the Skokie Ditch – it also cuts through the Onwentsia Club a few miles away – is the only public golf facility in Lake Bluff, but has plenty of nearby competition. The list includes the soon-to-reopen Sunset Valley, as well as Deerpath Golf Course in Lake Forest, Foss Park in North Chicago, Crane's Landing in Lincolnshire – reopening after severe flooding last August – Pine Meadow and Steeplechase in Mundelein, and a bevy of courses farther from Lake Michigan.

It's that competition that Lake Bluff has apparently found it difficult to compete against in this era of fewer golfers playing fewer rounds, even with Billy Casper Golf, which runs courses economically, holding the management contract. That expires at the end of the year.

The Lake Forester reported that about 200 people, many of them golfers, were on hand for the Feb. 26 hearing, the first of two slated before an April 16 meeting where the course's fate may be announced. Most were in favor of the course staying open, though not all were from Lake Bluff.

If the course is eventually closed, it would be the 23rd facility in the Chicago area, and 18th public facility, to be shuttered since 2001. Only one, Cardinal Creek in Beecher, has reopened.

AROUND ILLINOIS Meyer makes cut at Valspar

Illinois senior impresses in second PGA Tour start

ylan Meyer was better prepared for the swirl that accompanies a professional golf tournament this time. He was ready for the crowds, for seeing famous pros on the range, for rubbing elbows with them in the locker room.

The Illinois senior had missed the cut in his PGA Tour debut last year in the John Deere Classic.

In last month's Valspar Championship in Florida, he made the cut, and beat three former U.S. Open champions and a host of other notables in the process.

As ties for 74th place go when you score 7-over 291 and finish 17 strokes behind winner Paul Casey, it was a good one. And it augers well for Meyer's future.

The future is around the corner.

"If I get the experience of being here and it's early in the season, I'm going to be able to compete against the highest competition you can get," Meyer said.

Unlike the Deere, where he received a sponsor's exemption from tournament director Clair Peterson, Meyer won his spot at the Valspar by scoring a victory in the Augusta State 3M college

tournament last year. (And he repeated the feat on Sunday.) Then he had to decide if he could play, since it fell in Illinois' spring schedule. Fighting Illini coach Mike Small prodded him to do so.

"It's kind of hard to say no to a PGA Tour

event," Meyer said. "It's kind of a win-win for both."

While Meyer was opening 70-74 to make the cut – he was tied for eighth with a group including defending Masters winner Sergio Garcia, Ti-

ger Woods and Illinois alum Steve Stricker after 18 holes – the following notables were slamming their trunks on Friday night: Jordan Spieth, Geoff Ogilvy and Retief Goosen, U.S. Open winners all, plus Henrik Stensen, Davis Love III, Camilo Villegas, Billy Horschel, Ryan Moore and Illinois natives Ryan Moore and Kevin Streelman.

That was different from his showing at Deere Run, where he was down the highway after 36 holes while fellow Illini Nick Hardy, who had played in the U.S. Open in 2015 and 2016, was making the cut.

"I was kind of caught up in the lights and everything, caught up in being in the first PGA Tour event," Meyer admitted before the first round on Innisbrook's testing Copperhead course. "This week is about taking care of business, knowing how to prepare correctly instead of wondering who is out here, who is playing.

"I know Tiger is out and that's kind of cool but I've got to stick to what I'm doing and figure out my game plan so I can perform the best I can."

Keep doing that, and he'll stick on the Tour. **Dixon's Timber Creek closes – for good?**

In 2007, Ron Keith and his son Brett stepped up when Dixon Country Club closed, buying the property on the north edge of the city and reopening it as the public Timber Creek Golf and Banquet.

Now, it's time for someone else to step up. The Keiths have poured more than \$1 million into upgrades of the golf course, pool and tennis courts, but the operation has never made money, Ron Keith is 74 and coming off heart surgery, and Brett lives out of town.

That's why they've decided to shut the doors of the 103-year-old property – where Dixon's

Ronald Reagan once caddied and where Jack Nicklaus once played through – unless a buyer who will keep the golf course open is found.

That's what Ron Keith said in January. So far, no takers.

"Despite our best efforts, we were unable to negotiate a transaction with a golf-oriented purchaser," they wrote in January's *Timber News*, the club's newsletter.

What Keith the elder doesn't want to do is sell to someone who would subdivide the 136-acre property for homesites. And while the property is outside Dixon's city limits, there have been talks with the city for annexation, which would be needed before a sale to turn the course into a municipal layout. Neither the city nor the park district has been approached about a possible sale, the *Dixon Telegraph* reported.

Edgewood Golf Course in nearly Ogle County closed after the 2016 season. Cows were spotted roaming on the grounds of the nine-hole course in Polo last year.

The Gambit is over

New owner Gary Dahmer sees a campground where once The Gambit Golf Course stood in downstate Vienna.

He's so sure, he brought in area fire departments for a controlled burn of the old Gambit Inn in December.

"They've never been able to have the opportunity to burn a hotel anywhere in the state of Illinois for training," he told WPSD-TV News.

Dahmer sees 250 jobs created from his campground concept, which is immediately off Interstate 24 on Illinois 146, and near Interstate 57. The campground will include a modern motel, plus cottages.

"It's in the middle of everything," Dahmer

said.

The Gambit was the only public golf course in Johnson County, which has a population of about 12,500, according to the 2010 census. Opened in 1996, the Rich Osborne design measured 6,546 yards and played to a par of 71. It was reasonably well-regarded but suffered from a lack of customers, and closed at the end of the 2015 season.

Prices going up in Quincy

Rounds will go up \$2 on the 18-hole layout and season passes will jump \$20 at Quincy's Westview Golf Course, which is expected to keep revenues even with expenses.

Last year, the 27-hole facility finished about \$92,000 ahead, the park board reported in November, even though rounds dropped by about 2,000 compared to 2016.
