Yet, we all were there, filled with joy and excitement as we celebrated the resurrection of our Lord! Like the new beginnings we witnessed in creation in early Spring, we were energized by the new beginnings of our souls as we celebrated the promises won for us by our Risen Savior! It was a joyous time! And after the Service was over, we all piled in our cars and headed to Church to get ready for the next Service - AND to warm up!!

I am sure you have your own Easter memories. And I am sure those memories stay with us only because they are connected to the importance of the day in which we gather - that Easter IS important to us because we hold so dear promises connected to it, and the hope that it brings us, because our Savior did conquer sin and death for us. There indeed is the hope of new life and new beginnings because of the very real event of that first Easter!
