Question	Response
1) What date did the Digital Court Program start?	The Digital Court Program was established in 2016, with the first iteration focussed on the delivery of digital systems in the Family Law jurisdiction. The second (and current) current iteration of the DCP was established in the second half of 2021, with a significantly expanded scope to progressively consolidate a range of digital services across the Listed Entity.
2) When is the Digital Court Program finish/completion date?	The Digital Court Program is delivering ongoing digital transformation activity across the courts with ongoing, iterative delivery. Funding for the program is reviewed annually through governance frameworks to ensure that it continues to represent value to the Listed Entity.
3) How much has been spent on the Digital Court Program?	Costs for the first iteration of the Digital Court Program (FY2016-17 to FY2020-21) totalled \$22,246,741. Costs for the current iteration of the program, which includes development of the CourtPath application, (FY2021-22 to FY2023-24) totals \$7,533,775 including capital and operational expenditure.
4) What cost-savings has the Digital Court Program delivered?	Initial program objectives have focused on user-facing efficiencies, in line with identified user need during the program Discovery phase. As the program continues, further savings will be realised through the decommissioning of underlying legacy infrastructure and systems.
5) What was the original delivery date of the Electronic Court File replacement?	Following project estimation and sizing in December 2022, Electronic Court File Replacement was originally scheduled to launch in October-November 2023.
6) What date did the CourtPath Electronic Court File replacement capability launch?	Electronic Court File Replacement was launched in March 2024.
7) Has all Electronic Court File functionality been replaced and delivered in CourtPath?	CourtPath has replaced user-facing functionality of the legacy Electronic Court File, with decommissioning of legacy components scheduled for 2025. Given the significant complexity of this project phase, some minor components must be implemented at the time of this decommissioning.
8) Has the legacy Electronic Court File solution been decommissioned?	In keeping with the program's business continuity risk mitigation strategy, CourtPath has been designed to operate alongside legacy systems until user acceptance has been measured across judicial and staff cohorts. Given the high levels of satisfaction with CourtPath, work is underway to decommission the legacy ECF system in 2025.
9) Does CourtPath utilise the legacy the Electronic Court File SharePoint?	CourtPath currently integrates with the Electronic Court File system as an underlying document and data storage solution.
10) What was the original delivery date for the Digital Court File replacement?	The Digital Court File replacement was scheduled to launch in June 2022.

11) What date did the CourtPath Digital Court File replacement launch?	The Digital Court File replacement launched in October 2022.
12) Has all Digital Court File functionality been replaced and delivered in CourtPath?	CourtPath has wholly replaced the user-facing functionality of the Digital Court File system.
13) Has the legacy Digital Court File been decommissioned?	At the initiation of the program, the intention was that the Digital Court File system would be maintained as the case document storage solution that would integrate with CourtPath. This solution was determined to not be viable for the needs of the courts and a subsequent decision was made to replace the Digital Court File with a modern cloud-based document storage solution. The Digital Court File will be decommissioned once the new solution has been implemented.
14) Does CourtPath utilise the legacy Digital Court File Court File OpenText?	CourtPath currently integrates with the Digital Court File system as an underlying document and data storage solution.
15) How many legacy systems have been decommissioned as a result of the Digital Court Program and CourtPath?	No legacy systems have been fully decommissioned as a result of the Digital Court Program and CourtPath.
16) Does CourtPath meet the Australian Government's web accessibility requirements, including the World Wide Web Consortium's Web Content Accessibility Guidelines version 2.1 (WCAG 2.1)?	While CourtPath has been designed and developed with web accessibility and user experience in mind, the system does not fully comply with WCAG 2.1.
17) When did CourtPath last undergo independent accessibility Web Content Accessibility Guidelines assessment?	Given that CourtPath is under active development, the system will undergo a WCAG 2.1 assessment, with necessary mitigations analysed once principal development work is complete.
18) Has CourtPath undergone an Infosec Registered Assessors Program (IRAP) assessment?	No.
19) As per the Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA), does CourtPath have a formal Authority To Operate, including System security impact assessment and System Security and Privacy Plan?	FISMA is not applicable to Australian government entities.
20) When did the Federal Court of Australia undergo an Essential 8 Maturity assessment?	June to September 2024.
21) What is the Essential 8 maturity level of the Federal Court of Australia?	The security classification of this information prevents us from providing any response to this question.
