

INFORMATION ON DAMES WEARING
40 et 8 PARAPHERNALIA

Dear Dames:

Once again we are receiving numerous questions concerning what 40 et 8 pins or insignia Dames may wear. This was established in 1980 and still holds true.



DO NOT WEAR THE FOLLOWING:



- 1) The official 40 et 8 insignia lapel button (triangle with 40/8 in center)
- 2) Chapeau Medallion
- 3) Officers title bars
- 4) Triangular Emblem embroidered or printed patch that Voyageurs wear on their jackets, vests, jumpsuits, etc.
- 5) Caps, jackets, vests, etc. containing lettering which would suggest membership of the 40 et 8.
- 6) Official patches of Merit or pins of Merit, jewelry with 40/8 attached

THE FOLLOWING MAY BE WORN ON BERETS OR DISPLAY VESTS

Any souvenir pin that is sold by Voyageurs, even if it has a triangle with 40/8 on the pin or program pins (Nationale, Grande, and/or Locale). However, a souvenir pin that is sold by Voyageurs with the emblem (triangle with 40/8) **MAY NOT BE WORN IN A LOCATION WHICH WOULD DENOTE MEMBERSHIP**, i.e. lapel.

A REMINDER ON THE "OFFICIAL LA FEMME SHIELD"

Dames, please remember any Grande Cabane or Cabane Locale wishing to sell an item, or article, using the "Official La Femme Shield" on it must first submit a letter requesting permission to use the "Logo", explain what the item is to be used for, for example, Grande Rendezvous, Cabane Locale Pin, etc., and a drawing should also be submitted.
