
## **Books of the Bible**


## What you will need:


- Pages with Old Testament and New Testament books printed on coloured paper or card. Use one colour for the O.T. page and another for the N.T. page.
- Scissors
- Stapler and Staples or
- A punch and paper fasteners

## Construction

- Pre-cut the eight strips or let the children cut them out. The strips should include the number at the bottom.
- Arrange the strips in numerical order, 1 being on top and 8 at the bottom.
- Punch a hole at the top of the pile and fit a paper fastener (A) or staple the pile (B). Cut off the square with the number at the bottom of each strip.
- Let the children learn a few books at the time. Every second strip gives the children a clue without them seeing the whole name. It also helps them understand how the books of the Old and New Testament are grouped.


